## 2024 - The Parade

1020 - Parade to form up on The Moor/Webber Street

## Order of March - TBC 10 June 2024

The Band<br>Standards (Two Files)<br>Veterans and Ex-Service Organisations<br>Armed Forces contingents<br>Youth organisations<br>The Civic Party will follow the main body of the Parade

1040 - Parade will leave The Piazza on The Moor via Webber Street and Church Street
1055 - Parade arrives at the Church of King Charles the Martyr
O/A - Standards to Fall Out and form up on both sides of the Steps outside King Charles the Martyr Church - Parade dismissed to enter the Church

O/C - The Band retire to The Huddle (Refreshments)
O/C - Lord Lieutenant/Deputy Lord Lieutenant takes their seat

## The Return March

1155 - The Band and Parade will re-form outside King Charles the Martyr Church. The Civic Party will make their way to the Saluting Stand situated on the Steps outside the Municipal Offices on The Moor.

- The Band and Parade will proceed along Church Street towards Market Strand
- Left wheel into Killigrew Street, after TESCO's Right Wheel towards the Library Steps, then hard Left Wheel onto the Piazza, 'Eyes Right' at the Saluting Dias Steps outside the Municipal Offices
- With Pendennis Band leading the Parade, after the Saluting Dias they will 'Hard Left Wheel' $180^{\circ}$ Degrees, followed by the Standards, Veterans Ex-Service Organisations and Armed Forces contingents to take up position to the rear of the Parade opposite the Municipal Office steps. Cadet Forces detachments, Scouts, Guides, Beavers, other Youth organisations and Civilian detachments e.g. RNLI, will form up in front of the Band etc.

O/C The Mayor of Falmouth, Councilor Alan Rowe, will inspect and then address the Parade. On completion the Parade will dismiss, with invited guests going into the Municipal Offices for a Civic Reception in the Atherton Suite.
